

PRYOR MOUNTAIN WILD MUSTANG CENTER REGISTRY ASSOCIATION

The Pryor Mountain Wild Mustang Center Registry Association is an organization founded and dedicated to the preservation and promotion of the Pryor Mountain Mustang.

Pryor Mountain Wild Mustang Center Registry Association is incorporated in the State of Wyoming and the Registry is recognized by the State of Wyoming. Herein is also referred to as PMWMCRA. This registry replaces the Pryor Mountain Mustang Breeders Association (PMMBA). All PMMBA registrations will be transferred automatically to PMWMCRA.

Definition of Pryor Mountain Mustang –The Pryor Mountain Mustang is a horse breed that has been genetically studied and has been determined to be a unique horse residing on the Pryor Mountains of Wyoming and Montana.

Eligibility For Registration – A horse that has been gathered by the BLM from the Pryor Mountains and is certified as a Pryor Mountain Mustang is eligible for registration. The get of two Pryor Mountain Mustangs is also eligible for registration. Any horse previously registered as PMMBA is considered registered as PMWMCRA. Horses that have outside bloodlines, i.e., crossbred with another breed of horse of any breed, are not eligible for registration as a Pryor Mountain Mustang. Mustangs that have been gathered from other areas are not eligible for registration as a Pryor Mountain Mustang. The registry is open only to full blood Pryor Mountain Mustangs.

Proof of Eligibility – Requests for registration must be accompanied by proof of eligibility. Such proof can only be as follows

1. A copy of adoption papers from the BLM showing the horse was gathered from the Pryor Mountains and auctioned by the BLM. The papers must show that the BLM rules and regulations have been met by current owner and the adoption process has been successfully completed.
2. If horse has been sold by original adopter, a bill of sale from original adopter showing sale to current owner.
3. The get of two Pryor Mountain Mustangs that are registered with the Pryor Mountain Registry . In this case, copies of the registration papers of both parents need to accompany the registration request.
4. In the event the parents of the horse being registered are not registered with the Pryor Mountain Mustang Registry, then other proof must be submitted, i.e., copies of adoption papers or a genetic blood test proving eligibility is acceptable
Acceptable blood tests must be performed by the University of Kentucky, College of Veterinary Science, Lexington KY. No other blood test is acceptable.

Application for Registry - Applications for registry must include the following:

1. Application for Registry completed by current owner.
2. Proof of eligibility.

3. Four (4) color photos of horse being registered. Such photos must show exact color of horse at all four (4) quarters. Photos must show full face and full leg markings including hooves.
4. Applicable registration fees.

Registration Fees -

1. Members of PMWMCRA.– Registration Fee \$25.00
2. Non-members of PMWMCRA – Registration Fee \$35.00
3. One-Time Color change – PMWMCRA. – Fee \$10.00
4. One-Time Color change – Non-members of PMWMCRA. – Fee \$20.00

Changes in Horse Registration –

1. No change in registration of horse name is permitted.
2. In the event the horse changes color, a one-time color change can be made. This must be accompanied by a new completed application, four (4) color photos, copy of original registration and applicable fees.

Change in Ownership – In the event that a horse is sold, the new owner is responsible to register the horse in his/her name. Former owner of horse needs to complete change of ownership on reverse of registration papers. In the event of death of the horse, owner should notify the PMWMCRA as soon as possible so horse can be removed from active registry.

Horse Names – Applicants must select at least three (3) names for horse being registered. Registry will attempt in all cases to award the names in order selected by applicant. No more than one (1) horse can carry a name. In the event of death of a registered horse, the name will not become available for a least one (1) year after name is retired. After the period of one (1) year, the name will again become available on a first come basis.

Membership in Pryor Mountain Mustang Registry Association - Membership in PMWMCRA is open to anyone with an interest in the preservation of the Pryor Mountain Mustang. Member is not required to be a horse owner. Membership is a life-time event and no annual dues are assessed. Membership cost is \$25.00, a one-time fee. Membership may not be transferred to any other person. To apply, simply send a written letter of interest and a check in the amount of \$25.00 to Pryor Mountain Mustang Registry, c/o Carnahan, P O Box 65, Fort Laramie WY 82212

Disputes – Any disputes over any matters relating to the Pryor Mountain Mustang Registry will be submitted to the PMWMCRA Board of Directors for resolution. The decision of the PMWMCRA Board of Directors is final and binding on all parties and will not be reviewed at any later date.

Rule Changes –From time to time it may be necessary to amend, append, rescind and/or add additions to these rules. Rule changes will be at the hand of the Pryor Mountain Mustang Board of Directors. A simple majority of Board Members voting is all that is necessary to change rules.
